INTRODUCTION

This booklet of active enrollment has been prepared by the Business Services section of the Santa Barbara County Superintendent of Schools Office for use by the public schools and other agencies in Santa Barbara County. The main purpose of this booklet is to make a record of active enrollment of school districts in Santa Barbara County available to school districts and other interested agencies.

Included in this publication is Table V, a "School Site Summary" of all school districts in Santa Barbara County. Table V results from requests received by this office asking for school site information such as numbers of students, levels of education and/or numbers of teachers. This is a continuing effort by the Santa Barbara County Schools Office to provide data and services which will be used by school districts and other agencies in overall educational planning.
