PREFACE

The California Basic Educational Data System (CBEDS) is a single annual collection of data by the State Department of Education (SDE) about school staff and enrollment. Its purpose is to satisfy the SDE's continuing need for information necessary for reporting, program management and planning. The system is designed to allow the data to be combined in many ways to serve various purposes and to reduce the number of information collections made by SDE. A CBEDS Profile, prepared by the SDE, is forthcoming in May or June, 1989.

This is a preliminary CBEDS Summary prepared by this office of school districts in Santa Barbara County. Enrollment and staff data was collected on October 19, 1988, CBEDS Information Day, and is provided by district, school, grade, male/female and ethnicity.

We hope this information will be of value to you until the official CBEDS Profile is available from the SDE.
