#### Preface

The California Basic Educational Data System (CBEDS) is a single annual collection of data compiled by the California Department of Education (CDE) about school staff, student characteristics, enrollment, and hiring practices. CBEDS is a statewide data base that has as its data sources county offices of education and school districts. Its purpose is to satisfy the CDE's continuing need for information necessary for reporting, program management, and planning.

The system is designed to allow the data to be combined in many ways to serve various purposes and to reduce the number of information collections made by CDE. Enrollment data was collected on October 12, 1994, designated as *CBEDS Information Day*, and is reported by district, school, grade, male/female, ethnicity, and an enrollment comparison over a period of 10 years.

The "official" CDE summary should be available in July/August 1995. The attached summary is the "unofficial" count prepared in our department. Please keep in mind that, during February 1995, districts are given an opportunity by the CDE to amend their reports. Therefore, amendments made after our summary was compiled are not included in this report. Districts are not required to submit these changes through our office.

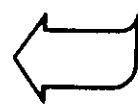
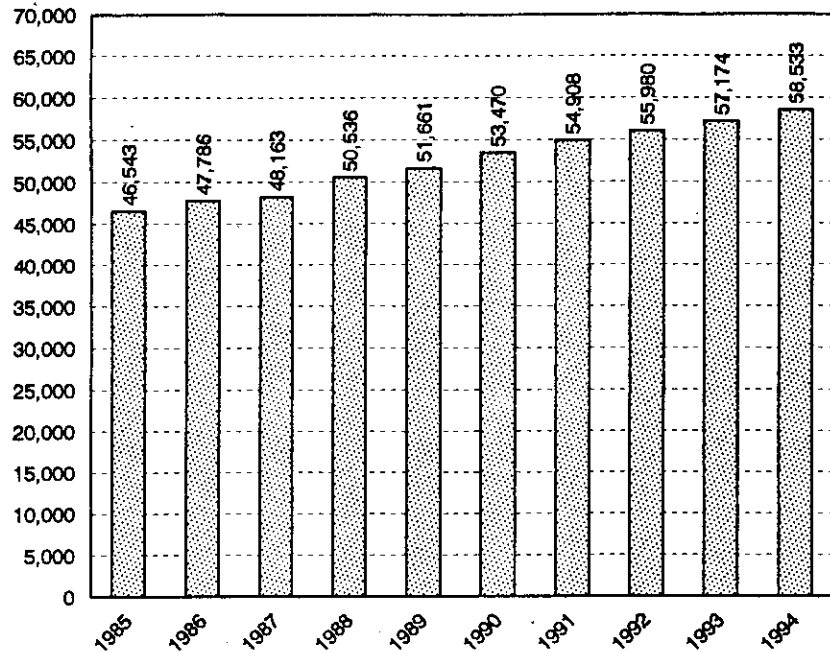

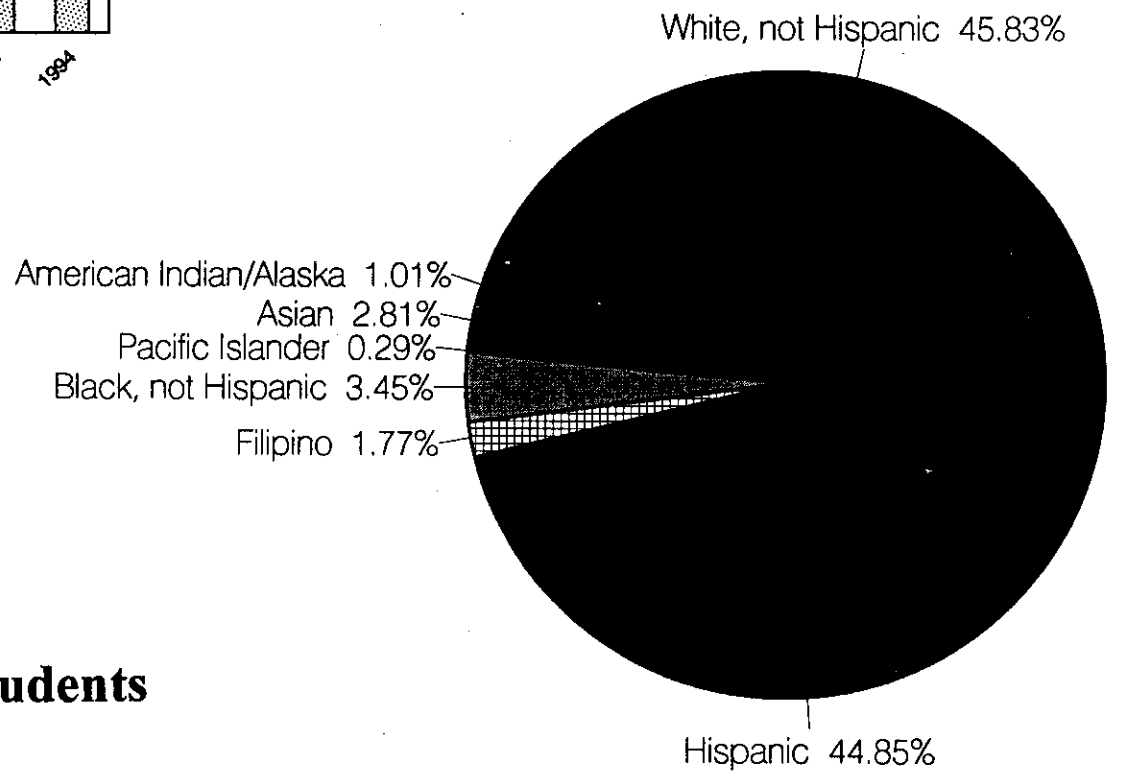
